Ties and Shoot-offs: All ties will be shot off, down to fourth, long runs after that. Doubles at stations 3-4-5. All shoot-offs will be miss and out by station according to NSSA rules, which will govern. Shoot-offs will follow the last rotation of the day.

Protests: All protests will go to the protest committee.

Liability: Spectators and contestants assume all risk of accidents.

Ammunition: The AGC stocks various types and gauges of ammunition. There will be ammunition available in limited quantities, so it is suggested each shooter bring enough of each gauge for the events and shoot-offs.

Referees: Referees will be assigned to each field for score keeping and pulling of targets.

Practice Rounds: Practice rounds are \$6.50 and will be available Saturday beginning at 8:00am.

Motels/RV's: There are numerous hotels and motels in Amarillo. There are many close to the gun club, but we recommend staying in the south or west side of town.
